

Old Parlor Worn Out? We'll Replace it with an All-Stainless **HERITAGE** Or Remanufactured **Germania** Parlor in just two or three days

Many times we just change the stalls and replace the old Rope Detachers with all-stainless Arm TakeOffs. No need to replace the Lo-Lines, Receiver Group or Vacuum System if they are still up to snuff.

Chances are your old parlor has a rigid front end with large enough stalls for the big cows. If a couple of heifers come in together, one slides up on the other and you wonder how you'll get to the udder you can't get to. Heritage and Germania Brisket Bars come with automatic indexing, *standard*, reducing the available space and nicely arranging the udders right there in front of you.

Conventional or Rapid Exit?

Rapid is better, especially in larger parlors - if you have the available space, 5 or 6 ft in front of the cows. Push the button and they are gone in 8 to 10 sec.
